


# YOUR UNITED WAY: AT A GLANCE

## The Programs We Fund:

United Way provides competitive grant funding for programs in these four main focus areas: education, income, health and basic needs.

## Direct Services We Provide:

The VRC connects individuals, families, students and corporate volunteer groups with opportunities to serve more than 100 agencies that need assistance stretching their precious dollars with volunteers.



Going2College is an initiative designed to reduce barriers to information about higher education. Going2College improves college access and helps simplify the application process by providing timely updates via text message.



United Way's Financial Stability Coalition assists low-to moderate-income families claim the federal Earned Income Tax Credit. EITC is credited with lifting more children out of poverty than any other federal program.



40% of people in the United States have skipped refilling a prescription due to cost. To address this, we've partnered with more than 600 other United Way agencies to distribute free FamilyWize prescription medication discount cards.

## HOW YOUR DOLLAR HELPS



**\$58:** Noontime meals for 50 hungry residents, including families.



**\$80:** Two weeks of quality childcare for a parent who is working several jobs.



**\$113:** Prenatal or postpartum care, patient education and case management for a mother and her baby.



**\$350:** Assistance with utilities, financial education and a week's worth of food for a struggling family.



**\$488:** Job training, education and financial literacy classes to assist people in becoming economically self-sufficient.



**\$1,250:** provides one year of quality after-school programs offering leadership, recreational and enrichment activities for a teen.
